OPENING OF HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER (SECTION 8) WAITING LIST

The Board of Commissioners of the Secaucus Housing Authority hereby announces that applications will be accepted for the Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) waiting list. Only applications for those living and/or working in the Town of Secaucus will be accepted. Veterans may also apply. Applications will be available at the following locations starting Monday February 4th 2019:

Secaucus Housing Authority - 700 County Avenue Secaucus NJ, 07094

Secaucus Social Services - 101 Centre Avenue Secaucus, NJ 07094

Secaucus Town Hall (mayor's office) - 1203 Paterson Plank Road Secaucus, NJ 07094

All applications must be mailed to the Secaucus Housing Authority. Applications postmarked after February 8th 2019 will NOT be accepted as the waiting list will be closed after that date until further notice. Only one application per envelope will be accepted. No applications will be accepted by hand at the Secaucus Housing Authority.

Applicants must be 18 years of age & must be a U.S. Citizen or other eligible non-citizen. Applicants must also be income eligible. Applicants claiming residency preference must reside in the Town of Secaucus at the time they submit their application. Applicants claiming working preference must work in the Town of Secaucus at the time they submit their application. A veteran must have 2 year minimum service and have been honorably discharged.

Applications are placed on the waiting list in chronological order of the date and time they are received. We will notify you by mail if you qualify for placement on the waiting list. Applications will be made available in an accessible format upon request from a person with a disability.
